Shortly after noon Vlad came and picked us up and took us to his & Oksana's home for lunch. Oksana made a great "Shepard's Pie." She wanted to know if we had ever had it before and yes we have but, I must say hers was exceptional.

After lunch we worked on translating a PowerPoint presentation that I want to use Sunday morning. It is amazing how complicated it can be at times to translate just simple phrases. After the translation, Kate checked the grammar. When all was well, we went out to their garden for a few minutes and then returned to the building.

Vlad & I did our best to print my lesson for today but had no success. We could not get my computer to connect to the wireless printer and my document was in a different program that was not on the office computer. We finally gave up so he could go home and I came down stairs and spent some time converting my document into a format his software could read.

About 10:00 p.m. Ava & I both called it quits and turned the lights out.
